All four coaches have proved their worth in traffic but require regular and often expensive maintenance to keep them in a safe condition as well making sure they are comfortable and attractive for our customers.

The **EVRA** Team are now busy restoring a fifth coach, TSO (Tourist Second Open). When finished, this will mean **EVRA** has a rake of five coaches, which are urgently needed by the Ecclesbourne Valley Railway, especially to re-enact vintage steam and diesel events. The work is progressing well but needs **funding** to complete it.

Our Steam Locomotives

Currently the Ecclesbourne Valley Railway Association has three steam locomotives on long term loan:

Hudswell Clarke: No.102 'Cathryn' 0-6-0T.

Andrew Barclay: No.3 'Brian Harrison' 0-4-0.

Andrew Barclay: No.2217 'Henry Ellison' 0-4-0.

'Brian Harrison' and 'Henry Ellison' require constant maintenance and consumables to keep them in good working order for the enjoyment of the many visitors to our railway. They also require boiler certificate renewals and major overhauls every 10 years which could cost in the region of several thousand pounds.

'Cathryn', our third locomotive, is currently well into its restoration. We are hoping it will soon be in working order to operate on the railway. Having both a large coal and water capacity it has the potential to operate a regular steam service between Wirksworth and Duffield.

Our Carriages

The Association has restored four British Railways Mark 1 Carriages:

BSK (Brake Second Corridor) 35006

CK (Composite Corridor) 15849

SK (Second Corridor) 24918

SO (Second Open) 3727 - This coach is now modified to provide a bar and catering facilities and is frequently used in train formations and for evening events on the railway.
